W	WATER	 Tank Water (Filtered) - Limited supply – go careful in the showers, make sure you turn the taps off properly - Fill drink bottles inside the building Dam Water – All Outside taps – not suitable for drinking
E	EMERGENCY	 Signalled by continuous ringing of bell All persons must leave immediately and go to the emergency assembly area - oval at the top of the sandstone stairs across from the car park. Stay here until given all clear Your leader/teacher will call 000 and inform Managers Equipment – Fire Extinguishers, Hoses and Blankets are for emergency use only All rooms fitted with smoke alarms. Report low battery signal to manager (intermittent beeping sound) Be aware of closest exits to your rooms (green lit signs) Phone list on Notice Board
С	CAMP FACILITY	 Keep cabins clean and tidy – no eating or drinking Bunks – not jumping down, use ladder Walkways – mezzanine floor, all stairs, servery and landing Stairs – use handrails, walking only on inside passages Fireplace and flue – risk of burns Mezzanine floor Bannister Rails – don't lean out over them Ladies toilets – leave light switch off due to sensor Sewerage System – Septic Tank – only body waste and toilet paper to go down the toilet all else in bins provided Property boundaries - not trespassing onto neighbouring properties. Out of bounds – Sheds, workshop, house, activities
Α	ANIMALS/ BIRDS AND FLORA	 Please respect their habitat, not breaking any trees or plants Observing animals and birds from a distance Encourage you to keep outside doors shut to stop birds and animals from coming inside
R	RESOURCES/ RUBBISH	 Dam. It is very deep. Please be careful If you use something, please return it to its right place Keep off equipment unless supervised by an adult Games Room / Lounge Room – Keep clean and tidy Rubbish – please place in bins provided Woodstack – no climbing on it Breakages/Not working – please let us know Damage costs due to poor behaviour (graffiti/holes in wall)
