Not Maintaining Tension on Rope	Injury, Falls,	Instructor to manage. Stop activity if not safe to continue ½ hour breaks between sessions to limit fatigue	2	4	M	Suitable First Aid Kit Constant supervision by assisting adult				
Person in immediate crate stack area	Injury	Seats are provided for participants who are waiting their turn away from crate stack area. Instructor to have barrier in place prior to starting and must wear a helmet Boundary around immediate crate stack area	1	4	M	Ensure waiting participants are sitting on the seats/stairs

Broken/Damaged Equipment	Injury	Regular checking and maintenance of Equipment Correct instruction so equipment does not get damaged	2	4	M	Reporting of any concerns, incidents to group leader and camp management				
Damaged/broken crate	Injury	Regular inspection of crates and replacement as necessary	3	3	М	Inspection prior to immediate use				
Worn/Damaged rope	Injury	Regular inspection of Rope and replacement as necessary	3	3	M	Inspection prior to immediate use
